BOIL WATER ALERT LIFTED

Effective date: **Tuesday, April 23, 2024 at 2:50 P.M.**

Jackson County Utility Authority – **JCUA West Water System (MS0300164, Jackson County)**

As of **2:50 P.M. Tuesday, April 23, 2024**, JCUA has **lifted its precautionary boil water alert** for its West Water System (MS0300164, Jackson County) for residents located in the **St. Andrews Area in Jackson County, including addresses located on the following streets: St. Andrews Drive; Braeburn Drive; Tantallon Drive; Glen Eagles Drive; Braemar Drive; Golfing Green Drive; Murifield Court; Inverness Court and Inverness Circle.**

Public Water System: JCUA West Water System (MS0300164 - Jackson County) lifted the precautionary “Boil-Water Alert” for customers who get their drinking water from their water system in **Jackson County**.

Tests performed indicates the water is now safe to drink.

When your Boil-Water Alert is lifted

Flush faucets for a total of ten (10) minutes to introduce system water throughout house plumbing.

Example:

- 1 Faucet — Run for 10 minutes
- 2 Faucets — Run both for 5 minutes
- 3 Faucets — Run each for 3-4 minutes

Flush any faucet **a minimum of two (2) minutes** to ensure clearing of the line serving the faucet.

- **Discard any drinks**, ice, food, etc., made during the Boil-Water Alert.
- **Rewash** any food or drink contact items (knives, forks, plates, etc.) with "cleared" system water.
- **Check water filters** (in faucets, refrigerators and elsewhere) and replace if necessary.
- **Run dishwasher** through a cycle or two before washing dishes.
