

JACKSON COUNTY UTILITY AUTHORITY BOIL WATER ALERT LIFTED

Effective date: 10/30/2018

Jackson County Utility Authority – West Water System (MS0300164, Jackson County)

The Jackson County Utility Authority – West Water System (MS0300164) had issued a "Precautionary" Boil Water Alert for residents located in the St. Andrews neighborhood at the following addresses: Troon Circle-202, 204, and 206; Carnoustic Court- 205,207,209 and 211; St. Andrews Drive- 203, 205, 207, 208, 209, 210, 211, 212, 213, 215, 217, 219, and 221.

Public Water System: West (PWSID 0300164) lifted the precautionary "Boil-Water Alert" for customers who get their drinking water from their water system in **Jackson County**.

Tests performed by the Micro Methods Laboratory indicates the water is now safe to drink.

When your Boil-Water Alert is lifted

Flush faucets for a total of ten (10) minutes to introduce system water throughout house plumbing.

Example:

- 1 Faucet Run for 10 minutes
- 2 Faucets Run both for 5 minutes
- 3 Faucets Run each for 3-4 minutes

Flush any faucet a minimum of two (2) minutes to ensure clearing of the line serving the faucet.

- **Discard any drinks**, ice, food, etc., made during the Boil-Water Alert.
- **Rewash** any food or drink contact items (knives, forks, plates, etc.) with "cleared" system water.
- Check water filters (in faucets, refrigerators and elsewhere) and replace if necessary.
- Run dishwasher through a cycle or two before washing dishes.
